Class Registration

To enroll in the Summer Institute, a completed registration form with payment must be received at GPTS no later than the Friday prior to the class date. Non-GPTS students who would like to take the course for graduate-level credit must register with the Registrar by December 4th. Class registration fees include: course materials (syllabus, outlines, other media) and facility use. Attendees are responsible for their own expenses, including, but not limited to: hotel, airfare, meals, and assigned books. Participants are responsible for making their own accommodation arrangements directly with the hotel. **GPTS regrets that it cannot be responsible for any loss or damages incurred as a result of cancellation of a course by GPTS for any reason.**

Tuition & Fee Payments

The auditor fee for courses at Greenville Presbyterian Theological Seminary is \$30 USD per credit-hour for non-students. For classes outside of North America, fees in local currencies may apply. Contact the GPTS Registrar or the stated local contact before making final plans. Registration accompanied by full fee payment is required to guarantee a seat in the class. Payment in full is due at the time of enrollment. Please do not ask to be invoiced. A confirmation letter will be emailed when payment is received with completed registration forms.

Course fees are subject to change without advance notice.

Cancellation and Refund Policy

Paid or guaranteed registrations canceled in writing at least five business days in advance of a class will receive a full refund, less a \$25 service fee. Paid or guaranteed registrations canceled in writing within five days before a class will receive a refund of 50% of the registration fee. No refund or credit will be issued on cancellation requests received after a class begins. Transfers may be made from one student to another by written request up to the Friday before the class. Transfer request must be submitted in writing. All cancellation and transfer fees are subject to change at any time.
